RESOLUTION NO. 942

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO KING COUNTY FOR THE 1993 REGIONAL CONSERVATION FUTURES ACQUISITION PROGRAM FOR OPEN SPACE PROJECTS OF EXTRAORDINARY LOCAL SIGNIFICANCE. (NORTH WATERSHED ACCESS)

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Redmond has approved an Interlocal Agreement with King County regarding the Redmond Watershed Preserve, and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Regional Conservation Futures 1993 Bond Acquisition Program, Ordinance 10750, funding assistance has been authorized and made available in the 1993 King County Regional Conservation Futures Acquisition Program to aid in financing the cost of land for open space which has extraordinary local significance, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Redmond considers it in the best public interest to acquire an additional ten acres of open space north of the Redmond Watershed Preserve, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make formal application to the 1993 King County Regional Conservation Futures Acquisition Program for funding assistance in connection with the acquisition of an

additional ten acres of open space north of the Redmond Watershed Preserve.

Section 2. Any funding assistance received as the result of this application shall be used in the acquisition of an additional ten acres of open space north and contiguous to the Redmond Watershed Preserve.

Section 3. The remainder of the project funds will be derived from previous Conservation Futures Grant funds.


Section 4. The City of Redmond hereby certifies that the City is responsible to support all non-cash commitments to the local share should they not materialize.

Section 5. Any property acquired with financial aid through the 1993 King County Regional Conservation Futures Acquisition Program shall be placed in use as open space and be retained in such use in perpetuity unless otherwise provided and agreed to by the City of Redmond, the King County Open Space Citizens Oversight Committee, and any affected federal, state, and county agencies.

Section 6. This resolution shall become part of the formal application to the 1993 King County Regional Conservation Futures Acquisition Program.
