

RESOLUTION NO 964

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, SUPPORTING AN AMENDMENT/STUDY BY THE METROPOLITAN COUNTY COUNCIL TO AMEND THE BEAR CREEK MASTER PLAN DEVELOPMENT CONDITIONS TO UNLINK SR520 FROM THE MPDs AND REPLACING THAT CONDITION WITH A LEVEL OF SERVICE STANDARD.

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond did adopt a resolution during the 1993 legislative session, an ordinance in July 1993, and adopted a City legislative agenda in January 1994, all stating the City's strong support for the completion of the SR520 interchange project, and

WHEREAS, at the time the Bear Creek Community Plan was adopted, the Growth Management Act and its requirement of concurrency were not in place, and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Redmond strongly support the completion of the SR520 project for much needed relief of traffic congestion, and

WHEREAS, the congestion and level of service on SR520 have had a negative impact on our downtown and surrounding businesses, and

WHEREAS, numerous accidents have occurred on the bridge over the Sammamish River and the intersection of SR520 and Redmond Way has a very high accident rate, and

WHEREAS, the Eastside Transportation Program calls for the construction of this project as an essential element of the Eastside transportation system, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Redmond City Council supports amendments to the Bear Creek Master Plan to delete the requirement that the SR520 contracts be awarded prior to approval of the Master Planned Developments.

Section 2. Prior to rezoning of the MPDs, there must be a Master Transportation Agreement developed jointly between the City of Redmond and King County which identified MPD mitigation and concurrency requirements necessary to alleviate transportation impacts in King County and the City of Redmond, and which identified the funding responsibilities and commitments of all parties.
