Emergency Repairs to
NE 116 Street Bridge

RESOLUTION NO. 967

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, CERTIFYING THE EXISTENCE OF AN EMERGENCY REQUIRING THE PROCUREMENT OF ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION SERVICES FOR THE REPAIR OF THE N.E. 116TH STREET BRIDGE, WAIVING ANY AND ALL SELECTION AND BIDDING REQUIREMENTS, AND RATIFYING THE SELECTION OF CH2M HILL FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES AND THE SELECTION OF SHELDROP CONSTRUCTION FOR BRIDGE REPAIR.

WHEREAS, on February 18, 1994, while conducting an inspection of N.E. 116th Street, the Public Works Department discovered a severely crushed pier cap on a bridge located between the Sammamish Slough and the Willows Road, and

WHEREAS, a Certified Bridge Inspector from CH2M Hill was immediately contacted and determined, after an inspection, that the potential existed for immediate collapse of the structure, and

WHEREAS, based upon the potential for roadway failure, the Public Works Director ordered the immediate closure of N.E. 116th Street between Willows Road and the Sammamish Slough, and

WHEREAS, an additional inspection on February 22, 1994 revealed that the situation had worsened over the weekend even though traffic was not allowed on the bridge, and

WHEREAS, after informing the City Council at its work session of February 22 and based upon the further worsening of the condition, the Mayor and Public Works Director authorized the immediate commencement of repair work on February 23 and Sheldrup

Construction, Inc., a contractor performing the Union Hill Bridge Replacement Project for the City was selected to perform the repairs in accord with an estimate provided on February 18, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined to certify the existence of the emergency pursuant to RCW 35.22.620(6) and RCW 39.80.060, and to ratify the selection of CH2M Hill and Sheldrup without the necessity of complying with bidding and consultant selection procedures, now, therefore,


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Certification of Emergency. The Council finds that the facts set forth in the recital paragraphs of this Resolution are true and justify the declaration of an emergency. The Council therefore certifies that an emergency existed as of February 18, 1994 requiring the immediate procurement of engineering services and the immediate performance of repairs to the N.E. 116th Street Bridge located between the Sammamish Slough and the Willows Road. Without such repairs, the potential existed for the collapse of the bridge structure and the resulting damage to public property, rendering the bridge useless.


Section 2. Ratification of Selection of Consultant and Contractor - Waiver of Bidding and Selection Requirements. The City Council hereby ratifies and approves the selection of CH2M Hill to provide engineering and inspection services in connection with the emergency repairs. The Council also ratifies and approves the selection of Sheldrup Construction, Inc. to perform the

emergency repair work. Any contrary bidding or selection requirements in state law or City ordinance are hereby waived based upon the emergency nature of the work and services to be performed.
