

RESOLUTION NO. 978

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH KING COUNTY TO PROVIDE COURT SERVICES AND ESTABLISH CASE FILING FEES FOR MUNICIPAL CASES FILED IN THE NORTHEAST DISTRICT COURT.

WHEREAS Redmond has filed its traffic infraction, civil drug forfeiture and criminal citation cases in the district court operated by King County for many years, and is generally satisfied with the services provided by the County in this regard, and

WHEREAS a new Interlocal Agreement describing the services the County shall provide and the fees the City shall pay for those services has been negotiated by the City and the County thoughtfully and in good faith, and

WHEREAS the negotiated contract and its provisions are substantially improved over prior agreements, and are deemed acceptable to Redmond and to King County, and

WHEREAS the King County Council has committed by motion of June 27, 1994 not to seek modification of State law which would injure the City in regard to the cost recovery formula which establishes case filing fees based on the County's marginal costs, or the authority of the City to establish its own municipal court, and

WHEREAS Redmond desires to provide judicial services of excellent quality to the citizens of Redmond, and


WHEREAS Redmond recognizes the interest and the intent of the County to work cooperatively with the City to offer excellent services, and to continuously improve the quality and efficiency of the services provided by the District Court system, now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON
HEREBY RESOLVES THAT:

The Mayor is authorized and requested to enter into the Interlocal Agreement Establishing Filing Fees for Municipal Cases Filed in King County District Court which was signed by the King County Executive on July 1, 1994 and which accompanies this resolution, with the stipulation that language be added to Section 3.C.(2) of the Interlocal Agreement committing both parties to arbitration under Revised Code of Washington (RCW) Chapter 7.04, if renegotiation of material change in services does not reach successful conclusion.
