

RESOLUTION NO. 981

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,  
REJECTING ALL BIDS RECEIVED FOR THE  
REDMOND SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS,  
PROJECT 93-CI-07.

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WHEREAS, on July 14, 1994, the City opened bids on the Redmond Sidewalk Improvements Project 93-CI-07, and

WHEREAS, the low bid received by the City exceeds the engineer's estimate by 37% for the work involved, and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department recommends that the City Council reject all bids on the project and make a further call for bids in the same manner as the original call, and

WHEREAS, the City Council concurs in the recommendation, now, therefore,


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,  
HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Rejection of Bids. All bids received by the City in response to the City's call for bids on the Redmond Sidewalk Improvement, Project 93-CI-07, and opened on July 14, 1994, are rejected. The City will return all bid deposits to the bidders notifying them of the rejection.


Section 2. Further Call for Bids. The Public Works Department shall make further call for bids to construct the Redmond Sidewalk Improvement project in the same manner as the original call.
