RESOLUTION NO. 992

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 793 AND ANY SUBSEQUENT AMENDMENTS, BY AMENDING THE SCHEDULE OF USER FEES TO ADD A NEW ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY FEE FOR SIX-YEAR TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM PACKETS, AND REPEALING ANY REFERENCE TO SECONDHAND DEALER LICENSE FEES.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1480 of the City of Redmond provides that all administrative fees shall be set by Council resolution, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 793 passed by the City Council on April 4, 1989, establishes a schedule of "user fees" including penalties, administrative charges, permit fees, license fees, etc., and

WHEREAS, the City Council upon recommendation of the Public Works Department has determined that the schedule for "user fees" should be amended to include a new administrative policy fee for Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program Packets in order for the City to recoup its costs in the same, and

WHEREAS, the City Council recently removed from its code any regulations regarding secondhand dealers and licensing of the same within the City, and therefore any reference to "secondhand dealer license fee" should be removed from the user fee schedule, now, therefore,


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,
HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Six-year Transportation Improvement Program Packet. A new administrative policy fee for Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program Packets shall be added to the schedule of user fees, adopted by Resolution No. 793, and any subsequent amendments. The fee shall be \$5 for each packet. (See Attachment A).


Section 2. Repeal of Secondhand Dealer License Fee. That portion of Title 5 of the user fee schedule adopted by Resolution No. 793, and any amendments, that reference a fee amount for secondhand dealer licenses, is hereby repealed. (See Attachment B).
