Fire Dist #34 Property Tax
Requirements

RESOLUTION NO. 994

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, WAIVING THE REQUIREMENT FOR A SIX PERCENT TAX LEVY INCREASE CONTAINED IN THE AGREEMENT FOR FIRE PREVENTION, PROTECTION AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE BETWEEN THE CITY AND KING COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 34 FOR 1995.

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond and King County Fire Protection District No. 34 entered into an agreement on January 1, 1974 for the provision of fire prevention, protection and emergency medical care services by the City to the District, and

WHEREAS, paragraph 5 of the Agreement provides that the District must levy the maximum millage allowed by law upon the property within the District each and every year during which the Agreement is in effect, and

WHEREAS, paragraph 5 of the Agreement would therefore require the District to increase property taxes by 6% for collection in 1995, and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond is willing to waive its right to insist on performance of the requirement for a 6% tax levy increase, in order to give the District more flexibility in its tax levy decision-making, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,
HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Waiver of Requirement for Levy Increase. The City of Redmond hereby waives its right to insist upon the District increasing its property tax levy by the 6% maximum provided by law in 1994, for collection in 1995. The City's intent is to give the District complete discretion as to any increase in property taxes and to that end, the City agrees that the District may maintain the levy at the same level as passed in 1993, for collection in 1994, or may increase the same, as the District determines in its discretion.

Section 2. Effect of Waiver. The City's waiver of the 6% tax levy increase provision for 1994 shall not be construed as a waiver of any other provision of the agreement, nor as a waiver of the provision requiring a tax levy increase for any other time. Except as expressly provided in this Resolution, all other provisions of the Agreement for Fire Prevention Protection and Emergency Medical Care entered into between the parties on January 1, 1974 shall remain in full force and effect.


