## **RESOLUTION NO.** 999

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, REPEALING SECTION H OF RESOLUTION NO. 933 RELATING TO THE AUTOMATIC SUNSET AND REPEAL OF COMMUTE TRIP REDUCTION (CTR) PRINCIPLES AND EXTENDING SAID PRINCIPLES INDEFINITELY.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 933 of the City of Redmond establishes supporting principles for achieving Commute Trip Reduction (CTR) goals, and

WHEREAS, Section (h) of Resolution No. 933 provides for the automatic sunset and repeal of these principles on March 16, 1995 in order to ensure that the principles will be reassessed for approach and effectiveness by that date, and

WHEREAS, RCW 70.94.527 requires that the City continue to enforce CTR regulations and the City Council, after reviewing the principles set forth in Resolution No. 933, has determined to extend the principles in their current form for an indefinite period, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Repeal of Sunset Provisions - Extension of Principles. Section (h) of Resolution No. 933 of the City of Redmond, passed by the City Council on March 16, 1993,

is hereby repealed. The principles set forth in said Resolution for achieving CTR goals shall remain in effect indefinitely, unless further action is taken by the City Council.
