

An ordinance providing for the licensing and regulating of Punch Boards, Bingo games, merchandising machines, and any gaming devices And providing penalties for the violation thereof.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Redmond:

Section 1

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to operate within the Town of Redmond, any Punch board, Bingo game, merchandising machine or any gaming device, (other than skill games) without first having obtained a license therefor from the Town clerk in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 2

The following license fee shall be paid in advance to the Town clerk of the Town of Redmond by all firms, persons or corporations desiring and securing the privilege of operating any Punch boards, merchandising machines, Bingo games or any gaming devices.

All taverns where beer or wine is sold by the glass and/or bottles, the annual license fee shall be \$100.00

All places where Beer and/or wine is sold by the bottle only, the annual license fee shall be \$25.00

All other places operating the above devices shall pay an annual license fee of \$25.00

Section 3

This ordinance shall be retroactive and be in full force and effect beginning with September 1st 1946

The Town clerk shall issue a license of regulation size to each person, firm or corporation complying with the above provisions, which license shall be posted in a conspicuous place in the place of business where such gaming device or devices are operated.

The police authorities are hereby directed to have the provisions of this ordinance strictly enforced.

Section 4
Penalties

Any person, firm or corporation violating any provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00 or by imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than 90 days, or both such fine and imprisonment may be imposed.

Any ordinance heretofore passed that is in conflict herewith, is hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall not apply to any charitable or Non profit organizations.
