

ORDINANCE NO. 1026

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, ADDING A NEW SECTION 10.28.040 TO THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL CODE REGULATING THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES WITHIN THE CITY BY PROHIBITING CORNER CUTTING TO AVOID INTERSECTIONS OR TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES.


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REMOND, WASHINGTON,  
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A new Section 10.28.040 is hereby added to the Redmond Municipal Code to read as follows:

10.28.040 Cutting Corner Prohibited. It is unlawful for any person operating a motor vehicle upon any public roadway within the City to turn such vehicle either to the right or to the left upon approaching or leaving any intersection and to proceed across any property, whether publicly or privately owned and/or maintained, for the purpose of avoiding the intersection or any traffic control sign or device controlling the intersection, unless so directed by proper authorities.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after passage and publication by posting as provided by law.


