

An ordinance amending ordinance No 35 and repealing ordinance No.76 of the Town of Redmond.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Redmond as follows:

Sec. (1)

Section XI of ordinance No.35 is hereby amended to read as follows:

The Town of Redmond shall, as soon as possible, after an application has been made for the use of Town water, tap the main and install a meter and pipe and bring said pipe line to the property line of said applicant a distance not to exceed 40 feet.

Sec. (2)

The actual cost of said installation, including labor, supplies and material shall be borne by the applicant of said service.

This ordinance shall be retroactive and shall be in full force and effect beginning with September 1st 1946.

The provisions of this ordinance are necessary on account of the increased cost of labor, supplies and material.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances heretofore passed that are in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
