

ORDINANCE NO. 1040

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON AMENDING SECTION 5.04.050 OF THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL CODE TO CLARIFY THAT THE MINIMUM BUSINESS LICENSE FEE APPLIES TO PERSONS ENGAGED IN BUSINESS AND HAVING ZERO TO FOUR EMPLOYEES.

WHEREAS, the present business license fee schedule set forth in Section 5.04.050 of the Redmond Municipal Code should be clarified in order to establish that the minimum business license fee applies to all persons engaged in non-exempt business activities whether or not any employees are utilized in the business activity, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Section 5.04.050 of the Redmond Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

5.04.050 Fees - Payment (a) There is levied upon and shall be collected from every person engaging in business in the City an annual license fee in the following amounts:

<u>Employees</u>	<u>Amount of License Fee</u>
0-4	\$50.00
5-19	\$50.00 plus \$5.00 for each employee in excess of four
20-99	\$125.00 plus \$4.00 for each employee in excess of 19
100-199	\$445.00 plus \$3.50 for each employee in excess of 99
200 or more	\$800.00 plus \$3.00 for each employee in excess of 199

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after passage and publication by posting as provided by law.


