ORDINANCE NO. 105

---

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND  
TRANSFERRING NOT TO EXCEED \$ 5000<sup>00</sup> AND  
FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE STREET PAVING  
FUND

---

WHEREAS, the Town of Redmond has resurfaced certain streets and alleys within its incorporated limits with blacktop or asphalt paving and has adopted a voluntary assessment plan under which the owners of the property benefited by the paving have contributed to the cost of the resurfacing; and

WHEREAS, as the work progressed, it appeared that additional resurfacing of streets, not contemplated when the original plan was adopted, could be made at low cost by use of the same equipment, it being apparent that it was to the advantage of the town and its citizens to have the work done immediately without first collecting voluntary assessments from the owners of property benefited by the paving improvement, and

WHEREAS, by reason of this additional work, the moneys in the Street Paving Fund have been exhausted;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Redmond as follows:

Section.1. That a public emergency exists making it necessary to transfer from the General Fund to the Street Paving Fund a sum sufficient to defray the cost of resurfacing of streets and alleys not included in the original plan for

resurfacing, that the said emergency could not have been anticipated at the time the 1947 budget was adopted; and that the sum of \$ 5000<sup>00</sup> will be sufficient to pay the additional cost of resurfacing of said streets and alleys.

Section 2. That there is hereby appropriated for said purpose a sum not to exceed \$ 5000<sup>00</sup> from the General Fund of the Town of Redmond, which sum shall, upon the passage and approval of this Ordinance, be transferred to the Street Paving Fund.

Section 3. That, after the payments to be made into the Street Paving Fund on a voluntary assessment basis by the owners of property benefited by the resurfacing of streets and alleys, are completed, the money then remaining in the Street Paving Fund is to be transferred to the General Fund.
