

ORDINANCE NO. 1059

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING CHAPTER 10.48 OF THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL CODE REGULATING THE RIDING OF BICYCLES.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 10.48.010 of the Redmond Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

10.48.010 Effect of Regulations. (a) The parent of any child and the guardian of any ward shall not authorize or knowingly permit any such child or ward to violate any of the provisions of this chapter.

(b) The regulations applicable to bicycles shall apply whenever a bicycle is operated upon any street, public path set aside for the exclusive use of bicycles, and any combination sidewalk/bike lane established pursuant to Section 10.48.035, subject to those exceptions stated herein.

Section 2. A new Section 10.48.035 is hereby added to the Redmond Municipal Code to read as follows:

10.48.035 Combination Sidewalk/Bike Lanes. The Director of Public Works is hereby authorized to establish and designate certain sidewalks or portions of sidewalks within the City as combination sidewalk/bike lanes where such action is appropriate in light of the conditions of the adjacent roadway and vehicular and pedestrian traffic. The regulations set forth in Section 10.48.040 shall apply to the operation of a bicycle on a combination sidewalk/bike lane.

Section 3. Section 10.48.040 of the Redmond Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

10.48.040 Riding on Sidewalk. (a) No person shall ride a bicycle upon a sidewalk within the city center zone as designated on the official city zoning map, with the exception of a sidewalk which has been designated a combination sidewalk/bike lane in accordance with Section 10.48.035.

(b) The Director of Public Works is authorized to erect signs on any sidewalk or roadway prohibiting the riding of bicycles thereon by any person. When the signs are in place, no person shall disobey the same.

(c) Whenever any person is riding a bicycle upon a sidewalk or combination sidewalk/bike lane, such person shall yield the right-of-way to any pedestrian and shall give an audible signal before overtaking and passing any pedestrian.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after passage and publication by posting as provided by law.
