

Ordinance No. 106

an ordinance providing that a permit must be obtained for the privilege of constructing, altering and/or moving of any building into or in the Town of Redmond, and providing penalties for the violation thereof.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the town of Redmond as follows:

REPEALED

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to construct any building to the value of \$45.00 or more, without first having obtained a permit therefor

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to alter the exterior of any building to the value of \$25.00 or more without first having obtained a permit therefor.

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to move any building in or into the Town of Redmond without first having obtained a permit therefor

BY ORDINANCE NO. 106

Upon approval of the application for the construction, altering or moving of any building, the Town Council or some person designated by the Mayor, shall issue a permit without cost to the applicant for such construction, altering or moving of any building.

Penalty

Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$100.00 or by imprisonment in the County Jail not to exceed 30 days, or both such fine and imprisonment may be imposed. Each and every day that this ordinance is violated shall constitute a separate offense.
