

ORDINANCE NO. 1061

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING SECTION 1.10.010 OF THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL CODE REGULATING POSTING OF ORDINANCES.

WHEREAS, the Redmond branch of the United States Post Office is one of the official posting places for city ordinances and notices, and

WHEREAS, as of June 1, 1982, the Redmond Post Office has been relocated at 16135 Northeast 85th Street, Redmond, Washington, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1.10.010 of the Redmond Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

1.10.010 Posting of Ordinances. The City Council finds that there is no newspaper printed and published within the city and the City Council elects not to designate an official newspaper. Publication of ordinances of the City will be made by printing and posting the ordinances in the following three public places, all of which are designated as the official posting places for city notices:

A. A public bulletin board in the Redmond City Hall, 15670 N.E. 85th Street, Redmond, Washington, 98052;

B. A public bulletin board in the Redmond Public Library, 15810 N.E. 85th Street, Redmond, Washington, 98052;

C. A public bulletin board in the Redmond Branch of the United States Post Office, 16135 N.E. 85th Street, Redmond, Washington, 98052

Section 2. The City Council finds that a public emergency exists requiring this ordinance to become effective immediately upon passage in order to insure uninterrupted public notification of City actions, avoid confusion regarding the official posting places of the City and to preserve

the public's right of access to information regarding the actions of Redmond's municipal government.


