ORDINANCE NO. 1062

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON RELATING TO RECYCLING SOLID WASTE MATERIALS, ADDING A NEW SECTION 20B.70.075 TO THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL CODE AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT GUIDE; AMENDING SECTION 20B.70.020(20) OF THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT GUIDE; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Redmond Policy Advisory Commission conducted a public hearing on May 12, 1982, for the purpose of considering proposed amendments to the Redmond Municipal Code and Community Development Guide relating to recycling of solid waste materials, DGA-82-5, and

WHEREAS, at the conclusion of said hearing, the Policy Advisory Commission voted to recommend to the City Council that the Community Development Guide be amended as set forth hereinafter, and

WHEREAS, the City Council considered the recommendations of the Policy Advisory Commission at its regular meeting of June 1, 1982, and has determined that the proposed Development Guide Amendment should be implemented, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A new Section 20B.70.075 is hereby added to the Redmond Municipal Code and Community Development Guide to read as follows:

20B.70.075 COMMUNITY GOAL

Design a workable system to motivate citizens and businesses to increase recycling for the purpose of reducing the waste stream.

70.075(05) Policy

Encourage research, studies, surveys and demonstration projects to develop a safe, sanitary, efficient and economical recycling system.

70.075(10) Policy

Assist research, development and the promotion of technologically and economically feasible resource recovery programs including, without limitation, source separation, recycling and re-use.

70.075(15) Policy

Encourage the use of the capabilities and expertise of private industry and encourage volunteer efforts in accomplishing the purposes of recycling.

20.075(20) Policy

Promote programs and practices which reduce solid waste and increase source separation of recyclable materials.

70.075(25) Policy

Encourage the use of products manufactured from recyclable materials through City procurement procedures.

Section 2. Section 20B.70.020(20) of the Redmond Municipal Code and Community Development Guide is hereby amended to read as follows:

20B.70.020(20) Policy

Work toward regional management of solid waste.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after passage and publication by posting as provided by law.


