Ordinance No 107

An Ordinance Declaring an emergency and appropriating not to exceed \$2500.00 from the Water Revenue Fund for the removal of Silt and Debris from a Town storage Reservoir, located in the Southeast 1/4 of Section 28, Township 26 North, Range 6 E.W.M.

Whereas the floor of said Reservoir has become foul with Silt, Leaves and Mud, causing the water used by the Town to become unfit for consumption thereby causing an emergency to exist, and that it is extremely necessary that said emergency be remedied, and

Whereas it appears that the cost of remedying said condition will not exceed the sum of \$2500.00,

Now, therefore, be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Redmond as follows:

1

That said emergency does exist making it necessary to remove said Mud, Leaves and Silt in order to keep the Town Water Supply from becoming contaminated.

2

That there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$2500.00 from the Water Revenue Fund of the Town of Redmond, for the removal of said Leaves and Silt.

Introduced on September 17th 1947 by F.W. Buckley. Passed its first reading.

Passed its second reading on September 17th 1947 at an adjourned meeting and adopted.
