

ORDINANCE NO. 1072

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND,
WASHINGTON, AMENDING THE 1982 BUDGET
ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 1017, PASSED BY
THE CITY COUNCIL ON DECEMBER 22, 1981, BY
INCREASING REVENUES TO AND EXPENDITURES
FROM THE REVENUE SHARING FUND AND
DETERMINING THE PURPOSES FOR WHICH
UNANTICIPATED REVENUE SHARING FUNDS SHOULD
BE EXPENDED.

WHEREAS, at its meeting of July 6, 1982, the City
Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, conducted a
public hearing for the purpose of determining the manner in
which unanticipated federal revenue sharing funds should be
expended, and

WHEREAS, at the conclusion of said hearing, the City
Council determined that unanticipated revenue sharing funds
in the amount of \$72,574.00 should be expended for the
purposes set forth hereinafter, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The final budget for the fiscal year
1982, as adopted by Ordinance No. 1017, passed by the City
Council on December 22, 1981, is hereby amended by increasing
revenues to and appropriations from Revenue Sharing Fund
No. 199 in the amount of \$72,574.00, consisting of \$29,775.00
in unanticipated revenues for Entitlement Period 13 and
\$42,799.00 in unexpended carry forward from previous
entitlement periods. The sum of \$72,574.00 shall be
allocated as follows:

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Section 2. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1017, passed by the City Council in December 22, 1981, is hereby amended by revising the summary of totals of estimated revenues and appropriations incorporated in said section as Exhibit A to reflect the foregoing increase of revenues and appropriations.

Section 3. The Treasurer/Comptroller is hereby authorized and instructed to effectuate the necessary changes to the 1982 budget and to make all necessary and appropriate line item entries and adjustments in order to reflect the increases to revenues and appropriations as set forth in this ordinance.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after passage and publication by posting as provided by law.


