

ORDINANCE NO. 1075

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING THE 1982 BUDGET ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 1017, PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL ON DECEMBER 22, 1981, BY INCREASING REVENUES TO AND EXPENDITURES FROM THE CAPITAL EQUIPMENT FUND NO. 122.

WHEREAS, unanticipated revenues in the amount of \$2,400.00 have been received by the sale of surplus equipment by the Police Department which revenues should be deposited into the Capital Equipment Fund No. 122, and

WHEREAS, the sum of \$2,400.00 should be appropriated from said fund to pay the cost of replacing a police motorcycle radio unit, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The final budget for the fiscal year 1982, as adopted by Ordinance No. 1017, passed by the City Council on December 22, 1981, is hereby amended by increasing revenues to and appropriations from the Capital Equipment Fund No. 122 in the amount of \$2,400.00, the revenues consisting of \$2,400.00 received from the sale of surplus Police Department equipment. The appropriation of \$2,400.00 shall be expended for purchase of a police motorcycle radio replacement unit.

Section 2. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1017, passed by the City Council on December 22, 1981, is hereby amended by revising the summary of totals of estimated revenues and appropriations for each separate fund and the aggregate total for all such funds combined incorporated in said section as Exhibit A to reflect the foregoing increase of revenues and appropriations.

Section 3. The Treasurer/Comptroller is hereby authorized and instructed to effectuate the necessary changes to the 1982 budget and to make all necessary and appropriate line item entries and adjustments in order to reflect the

increases to revenues and appropriations as set forth in this ordinance.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after passage and publication by posting as provided by law.


