

ORDINANCE NO. 1078

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING THE 1982 BUDGET ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 1017, PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL ON DECEMBER 22, 1981, BY INCREASING REVENUES TO AND EXPENDITURES FROM THE EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT RESERVE FUND NO 120.

WHEREAS, revenue which was unanticipated at the time of adoption of the 1982 budget will be received in the form of insurance proceeds to be paid as a result of destruction of a Fire Department vehicle in an automobile collision in the amount of \$2,907.50, which sum should properly be placed in the Emergency Equipment Reserve Fund No. 120, and

WHEREAS, the expenditure of the sum of \$20,660.66 out of Emergency Equipment Reserve Fund No. 120 is necessary to replace the destroyed vehicle and to purchase an additional vehicle for the use of the Chief of the Fire Department, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The final budget for the fiscal year 1982, as adopted by Ordinance No. 1017, passed by the City Council on December 22, 1981, is hereby amended by increasing revenues to the Emergency Equipment Reserve Fund No. 120 in the amount of \$2,907.50 and by appropriating the sum of \$20,660.66 for the purchase of two vehicles for use by the Fire Department.

Section 2. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1017, passed by the City Council on December 22, 1981, is hereby amended by revising the summary of totals of estimated revenues and appropriations for each separate fund and the aggregate total for all such funds combined incorporated in said section as Exhibit A to reflect the foregoing increase of revenues and appropriations.

Section 3. The Treasurer/Comptroller is hereby authorized and instructed to effectuate the necessary changes

to the 1982 budget and to make all necessary and appropriate line item entries and adjustments in order to reflect the increases to revenues and appropriations as set forth in this ordinance.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after passage and publication by posting as provided by law.


