ORDINANCE NO. 1091

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING SECTION 4 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1077 PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL ON JULY 20, 1982, TO ESTABLISH AN EFFECTIVE DATE FOR THE ADDITIONAL ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT SALES AND USE TAX AS JANUARY 1, 1983.

WHEREAS, the City Council passed Ordinance No. 1077 in July of 1982, to establish an additional one-half of one percent sales and use tax as authorized by Section 17, Chapter 49, First Extraordinary Session, Laws of 1982, which tax was not to go into effect unless a similar tax was imposed by King County, and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that in order to continue to provide current levels of service to the public it is necessary to impose said tax effective January 1, 1983, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Section 4 of Ordinance No. 1077 passed by the City Council on July 20, 1982, is hereby amended to establish an effective date for imposition of the additional one-half of one percent sales and use tax as authorized by Section 17, Chapter 49, First Extraordinary Session, Laws of 1982, and to read as follows:

Section 4. Imposition of the local retail sales and/or use tax authorized by this ordinance shall take effect and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect as of January 1, 1983.

Section 2. This ordinance, being an exercise of a power specifically delegated to the City legislative body, is not subject to referendum, and shall take effect five (5)

days after its passage and publication by posting as provided by law.


