

ORDINANCE NO. 1096

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING THE FINAL BUDGET OF THE CITY OF REDMOND FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 1982, AS ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 1017 PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL ON DECEMBER 22, 1981, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 1049 PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL ON APRIL 20, 1982, ORDINANCE NO. 1072 PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL ON JULY 6, 1982, ORDINANCE NO. 1075 PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL ON JULY 20, 1982, AND ORDINANCE NO. 1078 PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL ON JULY 20, 1982, BY INCREASING REVENUES TO AND EXPENDITURES FROM THE RECREATION ACTIVITY FUND NO 110, FIRE DEPARTMENT DONATION FUND NO. 124, FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING FUND NO. 199, AND STREET BOND CONSTRUCTION FUND NO. 316.

WHEREAS, revenue which was unanticipated at the time of adoption of the 1982 budget has been recieved by the Recreation Activity Fund No. 110 and the Fire Department Donation Fund No. 124, which funds should be appropriated for the 1982 budget, and

WHEREAS, there are unappropriated sums carried forward in Federal Revenue Sharing Fund No. 199 and the Street Bond Construction Fund No. 316 which should be appropriated in the 1982 budget, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The final budget for the fiscal year 1982, as adopted by Ordinance No. 1017 passed by the City Council on December 22, 1981, and as amended by Ordinance No. 1049 passed by the City Council on April 20, 1982, Ordinance No. 1072 passed by the City Council on July 6, 1982, Ordinance No. 1075 passed by the City Council on July 20, 1982, and Ordinance No. 1078 passed by the City Council on July 20, 1982, is hereby further amended by increasing the revenues and appropriations to the following funds for the following purposes:

A. Recreational Activity Fund No. 110, increase the revenues by \$50,000 for unanticipated revenues and appropriate said sums for recreation class expenses.

B. The revenues to the Fire Department Donation Fund No. 124 are increased by the sum of \$9,000 representing unanticipated revenues and the same are appropriated for aid car expenses.

C. Revenues to the Federal Revenue Sharing Fund No. 199 are increased by the sum of \$87,695 representing

unappropriated sums carried forward from 1981 not reappropriated in 1982 which sums are hereby appropriated for Fire Department equipment and the Library sign.

D. Revenues to Street Bond Construction Fund No. 316 are increased by the sum of \$1,000,000 representing sums carried forward from 1981 not reappropriated in 1982 which sums are appropriated to be expended for street improvement purposes.

Section 2. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1017, passed by the City Council on December 22, 1981, as amended, is hereby further amended by revising the summary of the totals of estimated revenues and appropriations for each separate fund and the aggregate total of all such funds combined incorporated in said section as Exhibit A to reflect the foregoing increases in revenues and appropriations to and from the respective funds identified in Section 1 of this ordinance.

Section 3. The Treasurer/Comptroller is hereby authorized and instructed to effectuate the necessary changes to the 1982 budget and to make all necessary and appropriate line item entries and adjustments in order to reflect the increases to revenues and appropriations as set forth in this ordinance.

Section 4. This ordinance being one appropriating money and is not subject to referendum shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after passage and publication by posting as provided by law.
