

An ordinance establishing a Board of Trustees and providing for the enrollment of members of the Volunteer Fire Department under the Relief and Compensation provisions of Chapter 261, Pierce's Code, Session Laws of 1945 of the State of Washington.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Redmond as follows:

Section 1,

That in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 261, Pierce's Code, Session Laws of 1945 of the State of Washington, there is hereby created and established a Board of Trustees for the administration of said Act insofar as the same is applicable to the Town of Redmond.

Such Board shall consist of the Mayor, Town Clerk, one Councilman, \_\_\_\_\_, the Chief of the Fire Department, and one (1) member of the Fire Department to be elected by the members of the Fire Department for a term of one year and annually thereafter.

The Mayor shall be Chairman of the Board of Trustees, and the Town Clerk shall be Secretary-Treasurer of the Board of Trustees.

Section 2,

It shall be the duty of said Board of Trustees to provide for the enrollment of all members of the Fire Department of the Town of Redmond under the Relief and compensation provisions of said Act for the purpose of providing protection for all of said Firemen and their families from death or disability in the performance of their duties as Firemen and to provide Pension Retirement for any such Firemen desiring to take advantage of such provisions of said Act.

Said Board of Trustees shall perform all of the duties and exercise all of the powers as in said Act provided.

Section 3,

Immediately after the adoption of this ordinance and thereafter on or before the first day of March of each year said Board shall pay to the Treasurer of the State of Washington for the credit of the Volunteer Firemen's Relief and Pension Fund an annual fee of \$5.00 for each member of the Fire Department enrolled hereunder for the purpose of affording said Firemen with protection from death and/or disability as in said Act provided.

Section 4.

Whenever any such Fireman desires to take advantage of the Pension provisions of said Act, such Fireman shall pay, annually on or before the first day of March the sum of \$12.00 to said Board, excepting that the first payment must be paid upon qualifying after the adoption of this ordinance. The Town of Redmond shall add to said \$12.00 the sum of \$13.00 making a total of \$25.00 which total sum shall immediately be remitted to the State Treasurer and thereafter shall be remitted on or before the first day of March of each year to be credited as provided in Section 3.

Section 5

The membership of the Redmond Volunteer Fire Department shall be limited to a maximum of twenty five Firemen.

Introduced by F.W.Buckley on April 21st 1948, passed its first reading.

May 5 - 1948 passed its second reading and adopted by unanimous vote of the Town Council.
