

ORDINANCE NO. 1109

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING SECTION 3.56.040 OF THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL CODE TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT IN THE POLICE INVESTIGATIVE REVOLVING FUND; AND ADDING A NEW SECTION 3.56.045 AUTHORIZING A SPECIAL INVESTIGATIVE ALLOCATION TO THE FUND.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REMOND, WASHINGTON,
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 3.56.040 of the Redmond Municipal Code is hereby amended to increase the amount of funds to be placed in the Police Investigative Revolving Fund from \$1,000 to \$1,500 and to read as follows:

3.56.040 Establishment of Fund--Replenishment--Budgeting. The Treasurer-Comptroller is authorized and directed to issue a proper warrant or treasurer's check against the Police Department in the amount of \$1,500 to the custodian for the initial establishment of the Police Investigative Revolving Fund. As the fund becomes depleted because of expenditures incurred in police investigations, the Treasurer-Comptroller, upon authorization by the Chief of Police, may issue warrants or checks to replenish the amount in the fund. The Police Investigative Revolving fund shall constitute a clearing or controlling fund and is not a working fund of the City for budgetary purposes.

Section 2. A new Section 3.56.045 is hereby added to the Redmond Municipal Code to read as follows:

3.56.045 Special Investigative Allocation. In addition to the \$1,500 authorized by Section 3.56.040, the Treasurer-Comptroller is authorized and directed to issue to the custodian of the Police Investigative Fund a proper warrant or treasurer's check against the Police Department for the sum of \$3,500.00. This amount is not to be used for expenses, but shall be used for very specific, highly controlled investigative situations only. These funds will be kept in the investigative safe, except during an actual investigation, and will be returned to the safe upon completion of the investigation. A complete accounting of these funds shall be maintained.

Section 3. This ordinance, being an exercise of a power specifically delegated to the City legislative body, is not subject to referendum, and shall take effect five (5)

days after its passage and publication by posting as provided by law.


