ORDINANCE NO. 1115

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING THE 1983 BUDGET ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 1095, PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL ON DECEMBER 21, 1982, TO AUTHORIZE AN EXPENDITURE FROM THE EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT RESERVE FUND NO. 120 FOR THE PURCHASE OF VEHICLES AND RADIO EQUIPMENT FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, there is a need to purchase two Fire Department vehicles and to purchase radio equipment for said vehicles, the expenditure for which should be made from the Emergency Equipment Reserve Fund No. 120, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,  
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The final budget for the fiscal year commencing January 1, 1983, as adopted by Ordinance No. 1095, passed by the City Council on December 21, 1982, is hereby amended by increasing allocations from the Emergency Equipment Reserve Fund No. 120 in the amount of \$18,603.26 for the purpose of purchasing two 1982 Ford Granada vehicles and mobile radios for said vehicles to be used for the Fire Department.

Section 2. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1095, passed by the City Council on December 21, 1982, is hereby further amended by revising the summary of totals of estimated revenues and appropriations incorporated in said section as Exhibit A to reflect the increase in appropriations set forth in Section 1 of this ordinance.

Section 3. The Treasurer/Comptroller is hereby authorized and instructed to effectuate the necessary changes to the 1983 budget and to make all necessary and appropriate line item entries and adjustments in order to reflect the increase in appropriation of funds set forth in this ordinance.

Section 4. This ordinance, being an exercise of a power specifically delegated to the City legislative body, is not subject to referendum, and shall take effect five (5) days after its passage and publication by posting as provided by law.


