An ordinance creating a Planning Commission for the Town of Redmond.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Redmond as follows:

Section One. That there is hereby created a Planning Commission, the members of which will be selected by the Mayor and Council and must be legal residents of the Town of Redmond, and shall consist of not more than five members. Said Planning Commission shall have the authority to present to the Town Council any plan, plans or suggestions which will assist the Council in formating plans for the betterment and growth of the Town which will be orderly and to the best interests of the property owners and citizens residing within the Town limits.

Section Two. It shall be the duty of the Planning Commission to hold hearings wherein request for zoning or rezoning may be presented and where the proponents and opponents may present their arguments for and against such proposed zoning or rezoning. It will be the further duty of the Planning Commission to, after holding such hearings present to the Town Council their considered findings from the evidence presented at such hearings and their recommendations as to the decision that should be rendered.

Section Three. Upon request for zoning or rezoning of any piece of property within the Town limits, the Planning Commission will post notices as to the time and place at which a hearing will be held on such request on such property involved. Said notice must be posted not less than 14 days prior to such hearing.

Section Four. The Planning Commission is hereby empowered to formulate rules and regulations governing its actions all of which will be subject to approval by the Town Council before having full force and effect. No member of said Planning Commission can be removed therefrom except by vote of the Council.

Introduced on April 21st 1948 by Daryl Martin, passed its first reading. Passed its second reading and adopted May 5 - 1948
