

Ordinance No. 113

An ordinance covering Electrical installation and construction for the Town of Redmond, State of Washington.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Redmond as follows:

Section 1 The Town of Redmond by this ordinance hereby adopts the 1947-1949 Electrical Code of the State of Washington as the Electrical Code of the Town of Redmond and hereby sets a permit fee of Ten Cents (.10) per outlet as the cost of permits, and that no Electrical work shall be done in the Town of Redmond without a permit for same being issued by an appointed agent of the Town.

Penalty

Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not to exceed \$25.00 or may be imprisoned in the County Jail not to exceed 30 days or both such fine and imprisonment may be imposed, and each and every day that such violation exists, after due notice has been given, shall constitute a separate offense.

Introduced by J. A. Smith on April 21st 1948 and passed its first reading.

Passed its second reading and adopted on May 19 - 1948
