ORDINANCE NO 1142

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO STREETS; ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS ON CERTAIN STREETS WITHIN SAID CITY; CHANGING THE NAMES OF CERTAIN STREETS WITHIN SAID CITY; ESTABLISHING THE TIME LIMITS ON PARKING ON CERTAIN STREETS WITHIN SAID CITY.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The schedule adopted by Section 10.24.060 of the Redmond Municipal Code setting forth the maximum speed limits on certain streets within the city limits is hereby supplemented as follows:

NE 24th St.	Both Ways	Bel-Red Road	148th Ave. N. E.	30 mph
NE 20th St.	Both Ways	Bel-Red Road	148th Ave. N. E.	35 mph
Redmond Way	Both Ways	East City Limits	.25 miles East of E. Lake Sam. Parkway	50 mph
Redmond Way	Both Ways	.25 miles East of E. Lake Sam. Parkway	SR 920	40 mph

Section 2. The following streets located within the city limits shall, as of the effective date of this ordinance, have the names of said streets changed as set forth hereinafter:

Redmond-Fall City Road	Bear Creek	East City Limits	Redmond Way
N.E. 77th St.	164th Ave. N.E.	168th Ave. N.E.	Cleveland St.

Section 3. The schedule of parking restrictions set forth in Section 10.52.180 of the Redmond Municipal Code is hereby supplemented by establishing the following parking restrictions:

Cleveland St.	South	50 ft on south side at T-D Feeds (16355 Cleveland) between driveways		15 minute parking Load and Unload Only 8 AM - 6 PM
Cleveland St.	South	265 ft on south side from Brown Street	160th P1 NE in front of Gossard's Lumber and Hardware (16135 Cleveland)	15 minute parking Load and Unload Only 8 AM - 6 PM
N.E. 21st St.		152nd	Bel-Red Road	Two Hour Limit

Section 4. The traffic Engineer and Department of Public Works are hereby instructed to effectuate the changes contained in this ordinance and to erect the necessary signs and other notices required in accordance with applicable provisions of the Redmond Municipal Code.

Section 5. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect 30 days after passage and publication by posting as provided by law.
