ORDINANCE NO. 1144

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,
AMENDING SECTION 9.68.010 OF THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL
CODE RELATING TO INTERFERENCE WITH AND ABUSE OF
POLICE DOGS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 9.68.010 of the Redmond Municipal
Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"9.68.010. Interference with and Abuse of Police
Dogs Prohibited. It is unlawful for any person to
willfully or maliciously interfere, obstruct, tor-
ture, beat, kick, strike or in any way abuse or
harass any dog used by any police officer in
discharging or attempting to discharge any legal
duty or power of his office."

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and
effect thirty (30) days after passage and publication by
posting as provided by law.


