

ORDINANCE NO. 1159

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND,  
WASHINGTON, PROVIDING FOR INCREASES IN THE  
SALARIES PAID TO MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
ACCORDING TO A SCHEDULE, REPEALING ORDINANCE  
NO. 779, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,  
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The salaries to be paid to members of the  
Redmond City Council shall be increased from the present rate  
of \$200.00 per month or \$2,400.00 annually according to the  
following schedule:

<u>EFFECTIVE DATE</u>	<u>MONTHLY</u>	<u>ANNUALLY</u>
January 1, 1984	\$250.00	\$3,000.00
January 1, 1985	300.00	3,600.00
January 1, 1986	400.00	4,800.00

Provided, however, that pursuant to RCW 35A.12.070  
the increases provided above shall not be applicable to any  
present member of the council during that member's current  
term of office, and all present members of the city council  
shall continue to receive a salary of \$200.00 per month  
during the remainder of their current terms.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 779, passed by the City  
Council on August 16, 1977, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance, being an exercise of a  
power specifically delegated to the City legislative body, is  
not subject to referendum, and shall take effect five (5)  
days after its passage and publication by posting as provided  
by law.
