

ORDINANCE NO. 1170

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING THE 1983 BUDGET ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 1095, PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL ON DECEMBER 21, 1982, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 1115, PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL ON APRIL 5, 1983 AND ORDINANCE NO. 1151, PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL ON SEPTEMBER 20, 1983, TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPROPRIATION OF EXCESS REVENUES AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, at the time of adoption of the 1983 budget, the amounts of revenues to be collected from various sources could only be estimated, resulting in the need to supplement the budget to provide for appropriation of excess revenues, and

WHEREAS, the City has received and will be receiving funds over and above the estimate for revenues to the general fund, and the street fund needs additional funds to cover unanticipated emergency expenses, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The final budget for the fiscal year 1983, as adopted by Ordinance No. 1095, passed by the City Council on December 21, 1982, as amended by Ordinance No. 1115, passed by the City Council on April 5, 1983 and Ordinance No. 1151, passed by the City Council on September 20, 1983, is hereby further amended by increasing revenues to and appropriations from the General Fund No. 001 by the sum of ~~\$30,000.00~~<sup>45,000.00</sup>, such revenues having been unanticipated, transferring the sum of ~~\$30,000.00~~<sup>45,000.00</sup> from said fund to the Street Fund No. 101, and increasing revenues to and appropriations from the Street Fund No. 101 by the sum of ~~\$30,000.00~~<sup>45,000.00</sup> to cover unanticipated emergency expenditures from the said fund for street projects properly chargeable to said fund.

Section 2. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1095, passed by the City Council on December 21, 1982, as amended by Ordinance No. 1115, passed by the City Council on April 5, 1983 and Ordinance No. 1151, passed by the City Council on

September 20, 1983, is hereby amended by revising the summary of totals of estimated revenues and appropriations for each separate fund and the aggregate total of all such funds combined incorporated in said section as Exhibit A to reflect the foregoing increases in revenues and appropriations as set forth in Section 1 of this ordinance.

Section 3. The Treasurer/Comptroller is hereby authorized and instructed to effectuate the necessary changes to the 1983 budget and to make all necessary and appropriate line item entries and adjustments in order to reflect the increases to revenues and appropriations as set forth in this ordinance.

Section 4. This ordinance being an exercise of a power specifically delegated to the City legislative body, is not subject to referendum, and shall take effect five (5) days after its passage and publication by posting as provided by law.
