ORDINANCE NO. 1185

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO PUBLIC STREETS, PROVIDING FOR ONE-WAY TRAFFIC ON GILMAN STREET.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. In order to improve the flow of traffic within the City Center area, traffic on Gilman Street from its intersection with Cleveland Street to its intersection with Redmond Way shall be restricted to northbound travel only.

Section 2. The Traffic Engineer and Department of Public Works are hereby directed to effectuate the restriction to one-way traffic flow by installing all necessary signs, striping or other devices necessary to advise motorists of the restriction to a one-way northbound flow of traffic.

Section 3. This ordinance, being an exercise of a power specifically delegated to the City legislative body, is not subject to referendum, and shall take effect five (5) days after passage and publication by posting as provided by law.
