ORDINANCE NO. 1186

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING SECTION 9.56.020 OF THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL CODE TO PERMIT SOCIAL CARD GAMES OPERATED BY NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS FOR THE EXCLUSIVE USE OF THEIR MEMBERS.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that Section 9.56.020 of the Redmond Municipal Code conflicts with RCW 9.46.295 insofar as it limits the scope of social card game activities, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has decided to permit social card games, conducted by nonprofit organizations for members only and that this decision requires a deletion of the prohibitory language contained in Section 9.56.020 of the Redmond Municipal Code, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 9.56.020 of the Redmond Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

9.56.020 State Law Applicable. Any license issued under the authority of state law to engage in any legal activities shall be legal authority to engage in the gambling activities for which the license was issued throughout the City, except that the City, in accordance with RCW 9.46.295 as the same now exists or may hereafter be amended, prohibits the following gambling activities within the City:

1. The conduct or operation of punchboards.

The effective date for the prohibition of punchboards shall be June 30, 1975, and pull tabs shall not commence sooner than July 1, 1976.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after passage and publication by posting as provided by law.
