ORDINANCE NO. 1194

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING TITLE 9 OF THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL CODE ENTITLED "PUBLIC PEACE, MORALS AND WELFARE" BY REPEALING SECTIONS 9.04.060 AND 9.04.050 AS IT RELATES TO THE ADOPTION BY REFERENCE OF RCW 66.44.270, RELATING TO MINORS CONSUMING AND POSSESSING ALCOHOL AND ADOPTING A NEW SECTION WHICH COVERS THE SAME SUBJECT MATTER.

WHEREAS, it is determined that the existence of two laws governing minors and their use or possession of intoxicating liquor has resulted in inconsistent interpretations; and

WHEREAS, the new section will clarify the subject matter for police officers, prosecutors and judges, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 9.04.060 of the Redmond Municipal Code entitled "Unlawful For Minor to be in Public After Consumption" is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Section 9.04.050 of the Redmond Municipal Code entitled "Alcoholic Beverage Control -- Enforcement" is hereby amended to delete the adoption by reference of RCW 66.44.270 entitled "Furnishing Liquor to Minors -- Possession, Use".

Section 3. There is hereby added to the Redmond Municipal Code a new Section 9.04.060 to read as follows:

Furnishing Liquor to Minors -- Possession, Use

(1) It is unlawful for any person under the age of twenty-one years to be or remain in any public place after having consumed liquor.

(2) It is unlawful for anyone under the age of twenty-one years to acquire or have in his possession or consume any liquor.

(3) It is unlawful for anyone to give or otherwise supply liquor to any person under the age of twenty-one years, or permit any person under

that age to consume liquor on his premises or on any premises under his control.

(4) Sections (2) and (3) above shall not apply when liquor is given or permitted to be given to a person under the age of twenty-one years by his parent or guardian for beverage or medicinal purposes, or administered to him by his physician or dentist for medicinal purposes or when liquor is being used in connection with religious services.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after passage and publication by posting as provided by law.
