ORDINANCE NO. 1223

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING REDMOND MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 9.04.310, ENTITLED "MISCELLANEOUS CRIMES," TO INCLUDE THE ADOPTION BY REFERENCE OF RCW 9.91.025 CONCERNING "UNLAWFUL BUS CONDUCT."

WHEREAS, the Redmond City Council finds that the adoption by reference of RCW 9.91.025, entitled "Unlawful Bus Conduct," is necessary to promote citizens' safety and welfare while riding in public transit vehicles, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 9.04.310 of the Redmond Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

9.04.310 Miscellaneous crimes. The following statutes of the state of Washington are adopted by reference:

- RCW 9.91.010 Denial of civil rights--Terms defined
- RCW 9.91.020 Operating railroad, steamboat, vehicle, etc., while intoxicated
- RCW 9.91.025 Unlawful bus conduct
- RCW 9.91.060 Leaving children unattended in parked automobile
- RCW 9.91.110 Meal buyers--Records of purchases--Penalty
- RCW 70.93.060 Littering

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after passage and publication by posting as provided by law.
