ORDINANCE NO. 1226

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING CHAPTER 2.60 OF THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO THE CITY CEMETERY TO REVISE THE PRICE OF CEMETERY LOTS.

WHEREAS, due to the increased cost of maintaining and operating the City's cemetery, the City Council has determined that the prices charged for cemetery lots should be adjusted as set forth hereinafter, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO  
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 2.60 of the Redmond Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.60.010 Price of Cemetery Lots. The price schedule for the sale of cemetery lots in the Redmond Cemetery, including the endowment fund contribution, shall be as follows:

| (1) Adult Spaces     | \$300.00 each |
| (2) Infant Spaces    | 175.00 each   |
| (3) Ashes internment | 240.00 each   |

260.020 Charges for Internment, Materials and Incidental Services. The Director of Public Works is authorized and directed to determine, establish and charge reasonable rates and charges for internment (opening and closing), for materials used or furnished in burials and for other services incidental to the operation and maintenance of the Redmond Cemetery. In establishing such rates and charges, the Director shall take into consideration the cost to the City in rendering such materials and services and the charges made by other cemeteries in the area for such items. The rate schedule to be established by the Director or any modifications thereof shall become effective on the filing of the same with the City Clerk.

Section 2. The prices stated in Section 1 of this ordinance shall become effective as of March 1, 1985, after publication of this ordinance by posting as required by law.
