ORDINANCE NO. 124

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor of the Town of Redmond to contract with King County Fire Protection District No. 34 to give said District the right to house its pumping engine and fire fighting equipment in the Town Fire Hall.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDMOND:

Section 1. That in accordance with the authority granted by Section 6 (3) of Chapter 254 of the 1947 Session Laws of the State of Washington (Rem. Rev. Stat., Section 5654-120, 1947 Supp.), the Mayor of the Town of Redmond is hereby authorized to enter into a written contract with King County Fire Protection District No. 34 whereby said District shall have the right to house its pumping engine and fire fighting equipment in the Town of Redmond Fire Hall during the period from March 1, 1949 to December 31, 1949, inclusive, and during such period said District shall have free and uninterrupted access to said Fire Hall for the purpose of maintaining and placing in operation said equipment; and the Town shall at its own expense furnish all heat, water and electricity necessarily required by the District in connection with its use of said Fire Hall; and for the space and services furnished by the Town as aforesaid the District shall pay to the Town the sum of \$100.00 per month, in advance, on the first day of each month during the period stated.

PASSED unanimously by the Town Council, and APPROVED by the Mayor, this 2nd day of March, 1949.
