ORDINANCE NO. 1243

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,
AMENDING SECTION 1.04.010 OF THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL
CODE RELATING TO INCARCERATION OF PERSONS CONVICTED
OF CRIMINAL OFFENSES.

WHEREAS, the Redmond City Council finds that Section
1.04.010 of the Redmond Municipal Code and Ordinance No. 74,
passed by the City Council in 1935, is outdated because the term
"police court" is no longer used in court rules and statutes and
the City of Redmond has contracted with the City of Lynnwood for
use of the Lynnwood Jail, and that said section should be
revised, now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1.04.010 of the Redmond Municipal
Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

1.04.010 Incarceration in Jails. Any person
receiving a jail sentence upon conviction in North-
east District Court shall be imprisoned in the King
County Jail, Lynnwood Jail, or other suitable jail
facility which the City has the right to use by
contract or interlocal agreement.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and
effect thirty (30) days after its passage and publication by
posting as provided by law.
