ORDINANCE NO. 125

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor of the Town of Redmond to contract with King County Fire Protection District No. 34 to give the District the right to use the Town's fire hydrants.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDMOND:

Section 1. That in accordance with the authority granted by Section 6 (3) of Chapter 254 of the 1947 Session Laws of the State of Washington (Rem. Rev. Stat. § 5654-120, 1947 Supp.) the Mayor of the Town of Redmond is hereby authorized to enter into a written contract with the King County Fire Protection District No. 34, whereby the District, for a period of five (5) years, commencing March 1, 1949, to February 28, 1954, inclusive, shall have the right to connect to and use any of the fire hydrants of the Town for the purpose of extinguishing any fire in any portion of the District, at a charge of \$2.00 each for any hydrant so used, payable on the first day of each month, based upon the number of fire hydrants so used by the District in the preceding month.

PASSED unanimously by the Town Council and APPROVED by the Mayor, this 2nd day of March, 1949.
