ORDINANCE NO. 1268

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, ADDING A NEW CHAPTER 3.70 TO THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL CODE ENTITLED "DRUG ENFORCEMENT FUND" WHICH CREATES A SPECIAL FUND FOR MONIES RECEIVED AS A RESULT OF DRUG ENFORCEMENT SEIZURES; AUTHORIZES THE EXPENDITURE OF SUCH MONIES FOR THE PURCHASE, LEASE AND MAINTENANCE OF EQUIPMENT AND OTHER ITEMS NECESSARY FOR DRUG INVESTIGATIONS CONDUCTED BY THE REDMOND POLICE DEPARTMENT; AND PROVIDES THAT UNEXPENDED FUNDS SHALL BE CARRIED FORWARD FROM YEAR TO YEAR UNTIL EXPENDED FOR THE PURPOSES SET FORTH HEREIN.

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WHEREAS, the Redmond City Council finds that the creation of a special fund pursuant to RCW 35A.37 for monies received as a result of drug investigation seizures is necessary to pay for expenses incurred during drug investigations, and

WHEREAS, the Redmond City Council finds that establishing a "Drug Enforcement Fund" is in the interest of the public health, safety and welfare, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby added to the Redmond Municipal Code, a new Chapter 3.70 entitled "Drug Enforcement Fund" to read as follows:

3.70.010 Fund Created. There is hereby created and established a special fund to be known as the "Drug Enforcement Fund" into which all monies and proceeds from the sale of property seized during drug investigations pursuant to RCW 69.50.505 shall be deposited, except the monies and proceeds governed by the provisions of RCW 69.50.505(f) when a forfeiture hearing occurs.

3.70.020 Purposes - Expenditures. This fund has been established for the purpose of accumulating funds for the purchase, lease and maintenance of equipment and other items necessary for drug investigations conducted by the Redmond Police Department. The monies deposited into the Drug Enforcement Fund shall be expended only for such purposes and for no other purpose unless otherwise directed by ordinance of the City Council.

3.70.030 Unexpended Funds. Any unexpended funds remaining in the Drug Enforcement Fund at the end of any budget year shall not be transferred to the general fund or otherwise lapse, rather said unexpended funds shall be carried forward from year to year until expended for the purposes set forth in Section 3.70.020 or as otherwise directed by ordinance of the City Council.

Section 2. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance or a summary thereof shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force thirty (30) days after the date of publication.
