ORDINANCE NO. 1278

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, ADDING A NEW SECTION 9.32.240 TO THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL CODE ESTABLISHING THAT VIOLATIONS OF PARK SPEED LIMITS, AND LITTER, PARKING AND CAMPING RESTRICTIONS UNDER SECTION 9.32.160, 9.32.170, 9.32.180 AND 9.32.200 ARE CIVIL INFRACTIONS PUNISHABLE BY A MAXIMUM PENALTY OF \$250.00.

WHEREAS, the Redmond City Council finds that it is necessary to establish certain park regulations to be civil infractions in order to make the penalty consistent with other state and City laws, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO  
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby added to the Redmond Municipal Code a new Section 9.32.240 to read as follows:

9.32.240 Penalty.

Any person violating any of the provisions set forth in Sections 9.32.160, 9.32.170, 9.32.180 and 9.32.200 shall have committed a civil infraction and shall be punished by a monetary penalty of not more than two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00). Each person commits a separate offense for each and every day during any portion of which any violation of any provision enumerated above is committed, continued or permitted by such person.

Section 2. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance or a summary thereof shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after publication as required by law.
