ORDINANCE NO. 1309

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,  
RELATING TO THE DESCRIPTION OF IMPROVEMENTS  
CONSTRUCTED PURSUANT TO LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT  
NO. 82-ST-44, AMENDING CITY ORDINANCE NO. 1132 TO  
INCLUDE THE IMPROVEMENT OF 36TH WAY WITHIN THE  
DESCRIPTION OF IMPROVEMENTS CONSTRUCTED PURSUANT  
TO LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 82-ST-44.

WHEREAS, the City Council has received written requests from the owners of property specially benefited by the construction of 36th Way, as more particularly described herein-after, to include the construction of 36th Way with those improvements directed to be constructed through Local Improvement District No. 82-ST-44, and after considering such request at a public hearing, the Council has determined that the improvement of 36th Way is logically related to the Local Improvement District No. 82-ST-44 improvements, and should be included within the LID for the purpose of financing said improvements, and the cost of said improvements should be borne by those properties which are specially benefited by such improvements, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO  
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 1132, passed by the City Council on June 21, 1983, and previously amended by passage of Ordinance No. 1297, on February 4, 1986, is hereby further amended by revising the descriptions of the improvements to be constructed as part of the LID 82-ST-44 improvements, by adding the description of the 36th Way improvements set forth on Exhibit A attached hereto, and incorporated herein by this reference as if set forth in full. Said improvements shall for all purposes be included in Local Improvement District No. 82-ST-44, together with those improvements identified in Ordinance No. 1132, as previously amended.

Section 2. This ordinance being an exercise of a power specifically delegated to the City legislative body is not sub-

ject to referendum and shall take effect five (5) days after publication in the City's official newspaper.

EXHIBIT "A"

N.E. 36th WAY (C-Line): Construct a street varying in width from SIXTY-EIGHT (68) feet to FORTY-EIGHT (48) feet within a right-of-way varying in width from ONE HUNDRED (100) feet to SIXTY (60) feet, extending from its intersection with 159th Ave N.E. and N.E. 36th Street (B-line) to a point approximately 864 feet easterly of its intersection with 159th Avenue N.E. and N.E. 36th Street (B-line), a distance of approximately 864 feet, by grading, surfacing with asphalt concrete paving, cement concrete curbs, gutters and sidewalks, slope protection, traffic channelization, sanitary sewers, storm drainage facilities, water mains, street illumination, together with all necessary appurtenances consistent with good street and utility construction.
