ORDINANCE NO. 1318

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,  
REPEALING CHAPTER 1.10 OF THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL  
CODE

WHEREAS, in 1985 the State legislature enacted RCW  
35A.12.160 which requires each code city to publish every  
ordinance after adoption in the city's official newspaper, and

WHEREAS, in the same legislative session, RCW  
35A.21.230 was enacted, which requires each code city to  
designate an official newspaper by resolution, and

WHEREAS, Chapter 1.10 of the Redmond Municipal Code,  
Posting and Publication of Ordinances and Notices is outdated in  
light of the recent legislation, and the subject matter in that  
Chapter is effectively dealt with by State statute and Resolution  
719, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO  
HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 1.10 of the Redmond Municipal Code,  
Posting and Publication of Ordinances and Notices, is hereby  
repealed.

Section 2. This ordinance, being an administrative  
action, is not subject to referendum and shall take effect five  
(5) days after publication in the City's official newspaper.
