ORDINANCE NO. 1341

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, REVISING THE DESCRIPTION OF THE IMPROVEMENTS TO BE CONSTRUCTED THROUGH LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 85-ST-48, AND AMENDING REDMOND CITY ORDINANCE NO. 1253.

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has determined that the description of improvements set forth in Redmond City Ordinance No. 1253 creating Local Improvement District 85-ST-48 is incomplete and that the description of improvements should be amended to be identical to that contained in Redmond Resolution No. 703 which established the date and time for the public hearing at which the City Council considered the formation of said LID, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1 of City of Redmond Ordinance No. 1253, passed by the City Council on June 4, 1985, is hereby amended to read as follows:

180th Avenue N.E. and 178th Place N.E.:

Construct a forty-four (44') foot wide street from curb-to-curb, extending from the Redmond/Fall City Road as the southerly limit, to the Union Hill Road on the northerly limit, a distance of 3,470 feet, more or less.

Union Hill Road:

Construct a fifty-six (56') foot wide street from curb-to-curb, extending from the Avondale Road as the westerly limit, to and including the intersection of 178th Place N.E. as the easterly limit, a distance of 640 feet, more or less.

Construction shall consist of installation of grading, surfacing with asphalt concrete paving, cement concrete curbs, gutters and sidewalks, bikeways, retaining walls, landscaping and slope protection, traffic channelization, traffic signal at the intersection of Union Hill Road and Avondale Road, sanitary sewers, storm drainage facilities, water mains, street illumination, underground power, and telephone communications, together with all necessary appurtenances consistent with good

street and utility construction and including acquisition of necessary right of way and easements, if any.

All of the foregoing shall be in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor prepared by the City Engineer and may be modified by the City Council as long as such modification does not affect the purpose of the improvement.

Section 2. This ordinance, being an administrative action, is not subject to referendum and shall take effect five (5) days after publication.
