ORDINANCE NO. 1363

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING TITLE 9 OF THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL CODE TO ADOPT THE STATE STATUTES GOVERNING HARASSMENT, SHOPPING CART THEFT, FALSE SWEARING, JURY TAMPERING, TAMPERING WITH PHYSICAL EVIDENCE AND SEXUAL EXPLOITATION OF CHILDREN; AMENDING SECTION 9.34.020 TO PROVIDE THAT THE OFFENSE OCCURS WHERE THE THREATS WERE MADE OR RECEIVED; CONTAINING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Redmond City Council finds that this ordinance is in the interests of the public health, safety and welfare, now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby added a new subsection (c) to Section 9.34.020 of the Redmond Municipal Code to read as follows:

(c) Any threat as defined in this section is deemed to have been committed at the place from which the threat or threats were made or at the place where the threat or threats were received.

Section 2. There is hereby added to the Redmond Municipal Code a new section 9.34.025 to read as follows:

9.34.025 Harassment. The following statutes of the State of Washington, including all future amendments, are hereby adopted by reference:

- B. 9A.46.030 Place where committed

Section 3. Section 9.36.010 of the Redmond

Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

9.35.010 Theft, UIBC and possession of stolen property. The following statutes of the State of Washington, including all future amendments, are adopted by reference:

- A. RCW 9.54.130 Restoration of stolen property -- Duty of officers
- B. RCW 9A.56.010 Definitions
- C. RCW 9A.56.020 Theft -- Definition, defense

Section 4. Section 9.40.020 of the Redmond

Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

9.40.020 Obstructing justice, criminal assistance, introducing contraband and related offenses. The following statutes

Section 5. Section 9.10.010 of the Redmond

Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

9.10.010 Conduct prohibited. The following statutes of the State of Washington, including all future amendments, are adopted by reference:

- A. RCW 9.91.060 Leaving children unattended in parked automobile
- B. RCW 9.68A.090 Communicating with a minor for immoral purposes
- C. RCW 9.68A.011 Definitions
- D. RCW 9.68A.070 Possession of depictions of minor engaged in sexually explicit conduct
- E. RCW 9.68A.080 Processors of depictions of minor engaged in sexually explicit conduct

- F. RCW 9.68A.110(2)(3)(5) Certain defenses barred permitted
- G. RCW 9.68A.120 Seizure and forfeiture of property
- H. RCW 9.68A.130 Recovery of costs of suit by minor

Section 6. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 7. The City Clerk is hereby directed to record an authenticated copy of RCW 9A.46.020-.100, RCW 9A.56.270, RCW 9A.72.040, RCW 9A.72.140, RCW 9A.72.150, RCW 9A.68A.110(2)(3)(5), RCW 9.68A.120, RCW 9.68A.130 and to maintain not less than one (1) copy of RCW 9A.46.020-.100, RCW 9A.56.270, RCW 9A.72.040, RCW 9A.72.140, RCW 9A.72.150, RCW 9A.68A.110(2)(3)(5), RCW 9.68A.120, RCW 9.68A.130 on file in the office of the City Clerk for use and examination by the public pursuant to RCW 35A.12.140.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force thirty (30) days after publication of the attached summary which is hereby approved.
