

ORDINANCE NO. 1386

**ORIGINAL**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING SECTION 20E.20.020 OF THE REDMOND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT GUIDE TO ADOPT THE 1987 EDITION OF THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE.

WHEREAS, under jurisdiction of RCW 19.28.060, the Director of the State of Washington Department of Labor and Industries has the authority to amend State of Washington electrical installations law, and

WHEREAS, the 1987 edition of the National Electrical Code (NFPA 60-1987) has been adopted under WAC 296-46-110 by the Department of Labor and Industries, and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the Redmond Community Development Guide should be amended correspondingly to reflect the change in State law, and

WHEREAS, these changes are administrative in nature and exempt from the requirement of review by the Planning Commission pursuant to Section 20F.20.240(15) of the Community Development Guide, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Section 20E.20.020 ADOPTION is amended to read as follows:  
20E.20.020 ADOPTION. The National Electrical Code, current edition, as specified by WAC 296-46-110, published by the National Fire Protection Association, one copy of which has been and is now on file with the office of the City Clerk for inspection by the public, is hereby adopted as the City Electrical Code by this reference and is incorporated herein as if set forth in full except as to such portions as may be deleted, modified or amended by the provisions of this chapter, if any.

Section 2. Section 20E.20.040 is hereby repealed.


Section 3. This ordinance, being an administrative action, is not subject to referendum and shall take effect five (5) days after publication.
