

Ordinance No. 139

An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 104, of the Town of Redmond, by changing the rates for Garbage Collection, and providing for a different place for Garbage Disposal.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Redmond, as follows:

1. That Ordinance No. 104 of the Town of Redmond, is hereby amended in the following particulars, to-wit:

A. By repealing Section 4 thereof and by substituting as a new Section 4 the following:

(Section 4. The town of Redmond shall from time to time, and whenever possible, have in effect an exclusive contract with some person, persons, or corporation, for the collection of garbage within the Town of Redmond at a fee, to be paid by the citizens served and to be collected by the Garbage Collector, of Ninety Cents (90) per month for the first can and Twenty-five Cents (25) per month for each other can from each private home and such fee to each business establishment as shall be agreed upon between the owner of such business establishment and the Collector, but in no event to exceed Ninety Cents (90) per month for the first container. Nothing in this ordinance shall be construed to prevent any person from properly disposing of his own garbage and refuse, but no one shall be permitted to render such service for hire except the holder of the contract with the Town.)

This Ordinance shall be in full effect on and after Oct 1st, 1950.

Introduced by Woodrow Reed on September 13th, 1950.
