ORDINANCE NO. 1403

ORIGINAL

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,
AMENDING SECTION 5.04.080 OF THE REDMOND
MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO BUSINESS LICENSES TO
DELETE CERTAIN SUBSECTIONS; RENUMBER THE RE-
MAINING SUBSECTIONS; ADD A NEW SUBSECTION
EXEMPTING NON-PROFIT BUSINESSES FROM LICENSING
REQUIREMENTS; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE
DATE.

WHEREAS, the provisions of sections 5.04.050(b) and 5.04.080 of the Redmond Municipal Code regarding businesses which generate or are likely to generate less than \$1,500.00 during a calendar year are inconsistent in that section 5.04.050(b) requires that such businesses submit an application and \$10. license fee, and section 5.04.080 exempts such businesses from business license requirements; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to remedy this inconsistency by deleting those portions of section 5.04.080 which exempt such businesses from licensing requirements; and
WHEREAS, the City Council finds that non-profit businesses provide benefits to the citizens of the City of Redmond which are not provided by businesses engaged in the pursuit of private profit; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds an exemption for non-profit businesses would benefit the public health, safety and welfare, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 5.04.080 of the Redmond Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

5.04.080 Exemptions. The provisions of this chapter shall not apply to:

1. National banks, State banks, trust companies, mutual savings banks, building and loan associations with respect to their banking business, trust business or savings and loan business but not with respect to engaging in any other business subject to the provisions of this chapter;
2. Any instrumentality of the United States, State of Washington, or political subdivision thereof with respect to the exercise of governmental functions;

3. Any farmer, gardner, or other person who sells, delivers or peddles any fruits, vegetables, berries, butter, eggs, fish, milk, poultry, meat or any farm produce or edibles raised, caught, produced or manufactured by such person in the State;
4. Family day care home occupations;
5. Any non-profit business operated without private profit, for a public, charitable, educational, literary, fraternal or religious purpose, upon furnishing proof to the City Clerk of its non-profit status.
6. Any apartment or condominium, residential rental or leasing activity which does not involve more than four residential units at any one location within the City.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force thirty (30) days after publication of the attached, approved summary.


