Ordinance No. 141

An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the Town of Redmond to enter into a contract with King County Fire Protection District No.34 to give said District the right to house its pumping engine and fire fighting equipment in the Town Fire Hall.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Redmond:

Section 1. That in accordance with the authority granted by Section 6 (3) Of Chapter 254 of the 1947 Session Laws of the State of Washington (Rem.Rev.Stat., Section 5654-120, 1947 Supp.) the Mayor of the Town of Redmond is hereby authorized to enter into a written contract with the King County Fire ~~Protection~~ Protection District No.34 whereby said District shall have the right to house its pumping engine and fire fighting equipment in the Town of Redmond Fire Hall beginning with January 1st 1951, this beginning date being retroactive.

And beginning with January 1st 1951 said District shall have free and uninterrupted access to said Fire Hall for the purpose of maintaining and placing in operation said equipment:

And the Town shall at its own expense furnish heat, water and electricity necessarily required by the District in connection with its use of said Fire Hall; and for the space and services furnished by the Town as aforesaid the District shall pay to the Town the sum of \$50.00 per month, quarterly at the end of each quarter.

The contract to be entered into by the Town and Fire Protection District No, 34 shall be for a period of Five years

Said contract shall contain a provision that same can be cancelled ^{by either party} by giving the other party six months notice to that effect.
